LICENCES	<p>Western Vic: Cooper Energy holds interests in six exploration licences in the onshore Otway Basin covering a total area of 8,350 square km. The company’s primary focus in this region is exploration for unconventional oil and gas. The larger part of this area is in Western Victoria although drilling has been carried out on the South Australian side of the border. Agreements were made with native title claimants regarding PEP150 and PEP 171 on the Western Vic side of the border. In the 2013 -2014 financial year a seismic survey in PEP168 near Warrnambool did not identify a drillable prospect. Further testing is scheduled for 2014.</p>
HISTORY	<p>Cooper Energy is an ASX-listed exploration and production company that produces approximately 500,000 barrels of oil per annum and conducts exploration for oil and gas in a portfolio comprising prospective acreage in the Cooper, Otway and Gippsland basins Australia, South Sumatra, Indonesia and the Gulf of Hammamet, Tunisia</p>
FURUTE PLANS	<p>Cooper energy is focusing on the Australian energy sector due to opportunities arising from the current changes, particularly in Eastern Australia and in onshore gas. They see the Otway and Gippsland basins as strategically significant areas of the gas market. The purchase of Somerton Energy in July 2012 strengthened their position in the Otway Basin where they intend to further test for unconventional gas in 2014. Cooper purchased 19.9% interest in Bass Strait Oil Company to improve its position in the Gippsland Basin.</p>
